## **ABSTRACT**

This thesis is about An Analysis of students' Understanding Sense Devices in Several Songs lyrics of Maher Zains. The method used descriptive qualitative method. The data was found from analysis students of song lyrics in several songs lyrics. The purpose of this research is to know how the students understanding of figurative language in several song's lyrics of Maher Zain. In conducting the research, the researcher used descriptive qualitative method. The population of this research is the eight semester students of English Study Program of Educational Departement of IAIN Curup academic year 2018/2019. The researcher used random sampling to determine students' understanding because the researcher want to know students understanding without any consideration. The instrument of this research is questioner. The findings show that of from 7 students there are 5 students have an good understanding in interpreting song lyircs and 2 students have good understanding in identifying simile with a percentage 80 %, from the others types of figurative language, metaphor, personification and allusion. The higher understanding is Simile, From the result about, especially in interpreting, the students need more practice to achieve a better understanding of figurative language.

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## CHAPTER I

### INTRODUCTION

This chapter consists of background of the study, research of questions, objective of the research, significance of the research, delimitation of the research, definition of operational and thesis organization .

#### A. Background

Song as one of form of literary works, meanwhile song has lyrics as same as poetry lyrics. Song or poetry is variety of literary works that expressed the imaginative thoughts and feeling. In the same context, if the song contains deeper imagination the listener or readers might feel a greater intrigued to the meaning delivered. Songs are common things that are often heard or easily known in everyday life. However, unwittingly hearing or singing a song can increase the listener's audience in several parts. In additions, songs are an important part in increasing the ability of the hearer. Songs can increase listening, speaking, pronounciation and also improve vocabulary by listening, singing and reading song lyrics as much as possible. Furthermore, the song has music, sound, rhythm, and beautiful lyrics. The lyric is the most important part of the song. In addition, Semi asserted that to the tone and music, the main element in a song is the lyrics.<sup>1</sup>

In line with that, Literature is a study about creations of art. There are many art in literature as poetry, drama, song and etc. In college, literature subject learned just one semester. As we know the language contained in poetry lyrics is more difficult to

understand because it has meaning that is not real sense. However, now language poetry also has in song lyrics. Moreover, not all students' like learn literary works. In addition, in this case the students' problem was that language used in lyrics, the words contain in lyrics are unfamiliar word and the vocabulary is uncommon words. So when they try to analyzing metaphor, simile, personification and allusion, they have difficulties. Furthermore, know that many students who fail and have difficulty in literary works of poetry or lyrics, so the researcher used the song lyrics as object. Based on phenomenon above, the researcher interested to do this research. In this research, the researcher was choosed Maher Zain's song because Maher zain has won many awards.

In addition, According to Amin Maher Zain is a singer from Tripoli, Lebanon which settled in Sweden and he is so famous with his voice and songs. This Lebanese-born man brings a new color in the world of international music that combines the genre of RnB music with pop music and spiritual characteristics of the lyrics, such that it distinguishes Maher Zain with other foreign singers. The album has achieved 8× platinum sales record in Malaysia as of January 2011 and has sold over 300,000 copies (20× platinum) as of June 2016. The album Thank You Allah has been certified multiple platinum by Warner Music Malaysia and Sony Music Indonesia. It became the highest selling album of 2010 in Malaysia. Besides that Maher Zain's lyrics using uncommon words and vocabulary is unfamiliar words. In addition, Maher Zains' lyrics also contain many metaphor, simile, personification and allusions. In this research, the researcher used of Mc Mahan's theory.

Furthermore, Mc Mahan stated that metaphor is an imaginative comparison in which two unlike things are compared by means of one element they have in common.

For example in Maher Zain lyrics, *I was a foolish child*. And then, simile is an imaginative comparison introduced by like or as or than. For example, *I saw the rockets and bombs shining in the sky like drops of rain in the sunlight*. Another type is Personification, giving human characteristics to nonhuman things. Such as, *I hear the flower's kind a crying loud*. And the last is Allusion, is language style that to show indirectly to events, persons, places, the things in history, those things already know together, the speaker or writer although listener or reader.

Based on the explanation above, the researcher is interested in doing research about sense devices from songs of Maher Zain. This research is entitled “**An Analysis of students’ Understanding Sense Devices of Several Songs Lyrics of Maher Zain’s**”

## **B. Research questions**

This is a question which will guide the researcher in conducting this research.

The question is formulated as follow:

1. How do the students’ understanding of simile in several Maher Zain song lyrics ?
2. How do the students’ understanding of metaphor in several Maher Zain song lyrics ?
3. How do the students’ understanding of personification in several Maher Zain song lyrics ?
4. How do the students’ understanding of Allusion in several Maher Zain song lyrics ?
5. How do the students’ general understanding toward those figurative languages?

### **C. Objective of the research**

The objective of this study are :

- a. To know how the students' understanding of simile in several Maher Zain song lyrics.
- b. To know how the students' understanding of metaphor in several Maher Zain song lyrics.
- c. To know how the students' understanding of personification in several Maher Zain song lyrics
- d. To know how the students' understanding of Allusion in several Maher Zain song lyrics.
- e. To know how the students' general understanding toward figurative languages

### **D. Limitation of the research**

In this research, the researcher limited the research only the analysis on how well students' understanding of figurative language in several Maher Zain song lyrics. Specifically, types of figurative language are includes simile, hyperbole, metaphor, personification, imagery, and allegory. However, in this research the researcher using of McMahan theory are simile, metaphor, personification, and allusion.

### **E. Definition of key term**

- a. Figurative Language

Figurative language is used in imaginative rather than literal sense, it is used widely in daily speech and writing.

## 1. Simile

A simile is an imaginative comparison that include the connotative such as; *like*, *as* or *than* but can also find similes that use *as* and other explicitly comparative words.

## 2. Metaphor

A metaphor is an imaginative comparison that it make use of the connotative values of words.

## 3. Personification

Personification is giving human characteristics to nonhuman things.

## 4. Allusion

Allusion is language style that to show indirectly to events, persons, places, the things in history

## b. Lyrics

Lyrics are the words of the song. The Lyrics are a set of words that make up a song. Lyrics can be studied from an academic perspective. For example, some lyrics can be considered as a form of social commentary. Lyrics can also be analyzed with respect to the sense of unity (or lack of unity) with music.<sup>2</sup>

## c. Maher Zain

Maher Zain (Arabic: ماهر زين ; born 16 July 1981 is a Swedish R&B singer, songwriter and music producer of Lebanese origin.

## CHAPTER II

### LITERATURE REVIEW

This chapter reviews related literature which includes the definition literature, meaning, definition of figurative language, types of figurative language, definition of song lyrics, biography of Maher Zain, the example of Maher Zain's song and previous study. This is done to give better understanding to the analysis and will be discussed in this chapter.

#### A. Literature

According to Eagleton stated that literature is as imaginative writing in the sense of fiction, writing which is not literally true. But even the briefest reflection on what people commonly include under the heading of literature suggests that this will not do. So, Literature most commonly refers to works of creative imagination, including poetry, drama, fiction, nonfiction, journalism, and song.<sup>3</sup>

According to Perrine<sup>4</sup>, literature is a kind of art, usually written, that offers pleasure and illumination. A literary work is imaginative work that uses literary language and ambiguous words. Most of literature work is using figurative and ambiguities to stimulate a certain image. It affects the language beauty of work in both oral and written. A song lyric includes as poetry and literary works. It is a poet that pronounced with

rhyme, tone, bars, and melody accompanied by music. According to Mario in his book<sup>5</sup>, etymologically the Latin word “litteratura” is derived from “littera” (letter), which is the smallest element of alphabetical writing. The word text is related to “textile” and can be translated as “fabric”: just as single threads form a fabric, so words and sentences form a meaningful and coherent text. The origins of the two central terms are, therefore, not of great help in defining literature or text. It is more enlightening to look at literature or text as cultural and historical phenomena and to investigate the conditions of their production and reception.

## **B. Meaning**

Meaning is at once the most obvious and most mysterious feature of human language. Meaning is also central to the experience of using language, as anyone knows who has ever listened to people talking in an unknown language. Not only does such a language fail to express any meaning; it is also often hard to catch hold of individual words: without knowing the meaning of an utterance, it is hard to identify the separate words which constitute it.<sup>6</sup>

## **C. Definition of Figurative Language**

Knickerbocker and Reninger stated that figurative language is an image used in particular way to explore the less known through the known. That is why we cannot interpret the meaning literally. In addition Hatch states that, figurative language has been described in terms of categories, namely simile, metaphor, allusion, personification, and

so forth.” All of them can be found in literatures, such as novels, newspapers, poems, and songs. Take the expression, “Life is like a camera” as an example. According to Ogunsiji, the purpose of figurative language is to capture readers’ interest and to deliver the idea and imagination in more entertaining way. It will present a lot of meaning or rich in meaning. Figurative language does not only decorate poems and endow them with aesthetic value, they also convey connotative meanings and produce certain special effects, which enrich the texts and make their meanings more precise and concrete.

McMahan, Funk, and Day,<sup>7</sup> stated that figurative language differentiated into four types, they are: metaphor, simile, personification, allusions. These figurative languages are famous in society, and also in the field of education starting from elementary school up to the senior high school and university level. From the explanation above, it is considered that figurative language deals with language which use figure of speech and language cannot be taken literary only and it is use to express the inner feeling of the writer

#### **D. Types of Figurative Language**

According to McMahan, Funk, and Day, there are four types of figurative language, they are:

##### **1. Metaphor**

McMahan, Funk, and Day stated that a metaphor is an imaginative comparison in which two unlike things are compared by means of one element they have in common.

“Thy eternal summer shall not fade,” it means to compare the youth and beauty of the

lover to the joys of summer. In addition, Lakoff in Afriani, states that metaphor is the expression of an understanding of one concept in terms of another concept, where there are some similarities or correlations between the two. So, metaphor is one of language style that compares a thing with another thing that has similarities.

Example:

- 1) My Home is Heaven
- 2) My lover is treasure
- 3) Life is rollercoaster

## 2. Simile

McMahan, Funk, Day said that simile is an imaginative comparison introduced by *like* or *as* or *than*. If you said, "*My sister is like a doll*," or maybe, "*My brother's good as gold*," you would be making a simile, a form of comparison in which one thing is compared to another unlike thing by using specific words of comparison. Poets try to find unusual metaphors and similes.

Hatch in Afriani stated that simile is a statement introduced by *like* or *as*. The structure of a simile is not too complicated. A clear example is given by Hatch "The alert faces of women shoppers, turning this way and that like foraging poultry". So simile is language style that compares a thing with another thing use connector words or comparison words, such as: *like*, *as* and *than*. Example:

- 1) I'm *like* a bird.
- 2) Her eyes are *like* stars
- 3) If I lose you, baby just *like* the clouds.

### **3. Personification**

McMahan, Funk, Day stated that those of us who love animals are so accustomed to personification, giving human characteristics to nonhuman things. In addition, Reaske in Afriani said that personification is the process of assigning human characteristics to nonhuman object, abstractions, or ideas”. Moreover, Hatch states personification is another category of figurative language. We talk about object as though they were people asking the listeners to assign the qualities of humanness to objects”. Whole of explanation above personification is language style that give human abilities and human reactions to nonhuman.

Example:

- 1) Just a smile and the rain is gone
- 2) Holding on to yesterday
- 3) The sun played hide and seek with the clouds

### **4. Allusion**

McMahan, Funk, Day stated that sometimes poems, like novels, stories, and plays, contain allusions (indirect references to famous persons, events, places, or to other works of literature). For example, “no, I am not prince Hamlet, nor was meant to be”. Knickerbocker stated as an exercise in allowing context throw light on allusion, imagine that you do not know the following persons or places mentioned in the sketch. Whole of explanation above, allusion is language style that to show indirectly to events, persons, places, the things in history, those things already know together, the speaker or writer although listener or reader. Example from song of Saosin Band the title of song is “Is

This Real”: *That's all it takes my son then you are safe, when the end comes, everything's okay.*

## **E. Definition of Song Lyrics**

Lyrics are words that make up a song usually consisting of verses and choruses.<sup>8</sup>

Lyrics reflect the individual journey or cultural observations of the songwriter. They are a serious art form.<sup>9</sup> Semi asserted that to the tone and music, the main element in a song is lyrics.<sup>10</sup> In our daily life, we are surrounded by songs. A song is like a magic that can hypnotize us, therefore, when we hear the songs we could be brought into the songs. For example, when someone is listening to a song, he can be brought into the story of the lyrics and the melody will play his emotion or feelings. Sometimes we did not realize that we could sing the songs without learning how to sing the songs in a certain way. From the songs we can learn many things, for example we can get some more new words, and we also could learn how the words are pronounced. As songs are having magical effects, we can use songs in the learning process.

In addition, the lyrics of a song are its words.<sup>11</sup> The Lyric is a media to express and to communicate what the author thinks or feels about. In other words, A lyric is a result of any kind of emotion of its author.<sup>12</sup> A Lyric is a set of words or unity paragraph. Meanwhile, the lyrics give the listener or reader deep understanding about the message contained in the song. In addition Dallin asserted that, lyrics are written as a form of

interaction between the writer and the listeners.<sup>13</sup> The lyric is a creation who has imagination in modifying beautiful words that have deep meaning. Clearly, the lyrics are expressing a personal feeling and thought to the listener or reader. While, the lyric was made by people that have creative or imaginative thinking. The writer of lyrics is a lyricist. The lyricist tries to express their feeling through words, is it sadness, happiness, love, special critique, message or about happened around them.

Moreover, Lyricist or songwriter puts some words figuratively in his lyrics. It will make lyrics beautiful sense and meaningful in his song. Simon Frith argues that three things are heard at once when listening to the lyrics of pop songs: words as a “source of semantic meaning”, rhetoric “words being used in a special, musical way” and voices “human tones” as “signs of people and personality.”<sup>14</sup> As Simons says above, the lyricist adds meaning that containing semantic meaning in the lyrics. It means lyrics is not just about a set word or sentences that people put in their writing that can be sung, however there are a lot of variety meaning in their imaginative writing that they are pour in their creation written.

## **F. Biography of Maher Zain**

Maher Zain (born March 16, 1981 in Tripoli, Lebanon) is a Moslem Swedish singer, songwriter, composer, musician and music producer of Lebanese origin. He comes from Sweden and his genres are R&B, soul music, pop music, world music, acoustic music, and Nasheed. Leaving behind a lucrative career in the mainstream music

industry in New York where he worked with internationally renowned producer RedOne. In early March 2010, Maher's debut album Thank You Allah (released by Awakening Records) was the No.1 highest selling album on Amazon in the world music section and Number 8 in the R&B section. Maher has already had concerts one of them is in Indonesia.

Maher Zain's first musical inspiration came from his father. Maher got his first keyboard when he was only ten and ever since music officially became part of Maher's world. The family moved to Sweden when Maher was only 8 years old, where he continued his schooling, and entered university and got a Bachelor degree in Aeronautical Engineering.

## **H. Previous Study**

Research about meaning has been done by some researchers before. To make sure that this research is original, the researcher wants to presents some research related to the semantics analysis meaning. They are:

Textual Meaning in Song Lyrics, Edwan Ali Firdaus 2013, aimed to find out the most frequent Topical Theme in the song lyrics. The study used Systemic Functional Grammar to answer the research questions. The data were taken from dreamtheater.net involving three Dream Theater lyrics. Data were analyzed by Halliday Theme and Rheme analytical framework. The research shows that Topical Theme is the most frequent

Theme which appears 70 times (68.63%) followed by Textual Theme which appears 28 times (27.45%) and Interpersonal Theme which appears 4 times (3.92%). The messages in the lyrics are mostly about love which is divided into three different points of view, i.e. the issue of love to an opposite sex, the issue of love to a son, the issue of love to life.

An analysis on connotative meaning and message in linkin park's songs in a thousand suns album, Nadia Aprilia Prayitna 2015. This research is aimed to show the interpretation of the connotations found in the song lyrics, the messages of the songs, and the contribution of the connotations to the messages. The problems of the study are (1) what are the expressions containing connotative meanings in the song lyrics of Linkin Park's A Thousand Suns album, (2) what are the messages of the songs in Linkin Park's A Thousand Suns album, and (3) how do the connotations contribute to the messages conveyed in the songs. This research used qualitative approach because the data are in the form of song lyrics. Documentary analysis was applied to find out the connotative meaning contained in the song lyrics, the messages, and the contribution of the connotations to the messages of the songs.

Interpersonal Meaning Analysis Of Muse Song Lyrics In Black Holes And Revelations' Album, Rowiatun Amri Marhamah 2014. This study examined the interpersonal meaning realized in the lyrics of Muse's album Black Holes and Revelations. It will be easier and more interesting to analyze the interpersonal meaning through the literary work that people hear every day such as song lyrics. The objectives of this study are to describe the types of interpersonal meaning, to describe the most dominant Mood Types, and to describe the Modality realized in the lyrics of Muse's album Black Holes and Revelations, The design of the research was descriptive

qualitative. The main sources of data in this research were the lyrics in the Muse's album Black Holes and Revelations. There were three song lyrics that the researcher analyzed in this research. The analysis of the data used the following steps: firstly, listened to the songs, found the printed lyrics of the songs, analyzed the clauses based on the Mood-Residue elements, describe the most dominant Mood Types, and found the Modality through Modal Finite and Mood Adjunct. The last, the researcher drew the conclusion of this study.

Relating to the some previous finding above, the researcher concluded that similarities of those researches above, with this research are talking about semantic meaning. the differences of the some findings above are this paper focused on meaning analysis muslim song while about to know how well students' understanding figurative language in Maher Zain's song. And also the different from previous research is not used the same theory, this research is using of Mc Mahan's theory to support the research, so the result of this research will different.

Based on these previous studies, the researcher is interested in the same topic but use different object. The researcher will do the study wide area. The researcher hopefully this study will be useful for another researcher that need to make study in the same field. To limit the research, the researcher will take Maher Zain songs lyric.

## **CHAPTER III**

### **RESEARCH METHODOLOGY**

This chapter presents the research method used in the study which consists of research design, Subject of the research, technique of collecting data, research instrument, and technique of data analysis.

#### **A. Research Design**

This research use Qualitative approach. Qualitative research is based on phenomenological stance, which emphasizes on the subjection aspects of people's behavior; the motives and beliefs behind people's action. However this research uses the descriptive qualitative method is used to conduct this research because the aim of this research is to know the students' understanding of sense devices in several songs lyrics of Maher Zain in a complete, detailed description but not to classify features, count them, and construct statistical models in an attempt to explain what is observed (Qualitative).

As Hancock explained that qualitative research is concerned with developing explanations of social phenomena, it describes social phenomena as they occur naturally.<sup>15</sup> In the qualitative research, the researcher is the most important collector data instrument.

#### **B. Subject of the Research**

##### **1. Population**

According to Arikunto population is a whole of the research object. Population is a set of data used investigated in which samples can be taken.<sup>16</sup> In this research, the researcher choose the eighth semester students of English Tadris Program of Education Departement of IAIN Curup academic year 2018/2019 have learnt figurative language theory in English Literature as population in this research.

## **2. Sample**

Arikunto stated that sample is a part of population is chosen to participate in research.<sup>17</sup> Furthermore, the researcher used random sampling technique, so the member of population has equal chance to be a member of sample. The students in seventh semester of English Tadris Program are around 38 students. In this research choose 7 (seventh) students' to be a sample based on random sampling, the researcher hopes with the sample of population will be covering the data from the research subject.

## **C. Technique of Collecting Data**

In this research, the researcher used questioner to collecting the data.

### **✓ Questionnaire**

Questionnaire is defined as data collection tool which written questions are presented that are to be answered by the respondent in written form.<sup>18</sup> The researcher tries to use questionnaire to get respond from students, how well their understanding of

simile, metaphor, personification and allusion in several song's Maher Zain. While, questioner has two forms are open-ended and close-ended. However, in this research the researcher used close-ended as instrument. A closed-ended is made up of pre-populated answer choices for the respondent to choose from. Moreover, in closed-ended question the participants answer the question by giving checklist in provided answer. A closed-ended question refers to any question for which a researcher provides research participants with options from which to choose a response. According to Dawson <sup>19</sup> mentioned some advantages in using closed-ended questionnaire.

- a. Tend to be quicker to administer
- b. Often easier and quicker for the researcher to record responses
- c. Tend to easy to code
- d. Respondents can only answer in predefines way
- e. New issue cannot be raised
- f. It is quick and easy for respondents to tick boxes, might be more likely to answer all the questions.

In this study, the researcher use McMahan's theory to design the rubric to collect the data. Furthermore, in this research, the researcher would take 5 song from Maher Zain's Albums to collecting data. The songs are *Hold My Hand*, *Insyah Allah*, *My Little Girl*, *Palestine Will Be Free*, and *Number one for me*. Maher zain has won many awards and appreciations. Besides that Maher Zain's lyrics using uncommon words and vocabulary is unfamiliar words. In addition, Maher Zains' lyrics also contain many

metaphor, simile, personification and allusions. In this research, the researcher used of Mc Mahan's theory.

#### **D. Research Instrument**

Research instrument is important to obtain the result of this study. It is a set of method, which is used to collect the data. In qualitative research, the researcher is the key-data collection instrument. The researcher tries to find out the answer of the problems of the study by analyzing the data which has been selected before.

Instrument of collecting data is choose tool and used by the researcher in the process of collecting data for making it systematic and easier.<sup>20</sup> While the main instrument in this research was researcher herself as the key human instrument. Besides, the additional instrument in this research is questioner close-ended. It was used to categorize the data into columns in the table based on the types of figurative language.

Here following table are questioner checklist analysis which contains of the types figurative language and their each indicator, which have function to indicates, explains, and also helps the researcher to do activity in the first table. To support the data the researcher used questioner in Maher Zain. The instrument data analysis was firstly validated by expert before the researcher used them to collect and complete data. The indicator how the sentence is could be called simile, metaphor, personification and allusion.

Classifying data was done after reading the data of student's meaning analysis.

The students' meaning analysis have been collected by research will be analyzing.

The researcher also will be calculating total number and percentage of each students' analysis to find out the level of students' understanding based on the following formula:

## CHAPTER IV

### FINDING AND DISCUSSION

This chapter presents analysis of the data based on McMahan's theory. Moreover, this chapter divided into two sections: findings and discussion. First, the researcher analyzing of the data found in Maher Zain's song lyrics based on research problem. Second, the researcher provides the result of data analyzed in section discussion.

#### A. Research Findings

This chapter is going to elaborate the analysis of Maher Zain's song lyrics in his albums with applying the simile, personification, metaphor and allusion. This chapter presents analysis of the data based on McMahan's theory. Below are findings for the types of figurative language which is used in Maher Zain's song lyrics by title hold my hand, Insya Allah, My little girl, Palestine will be free, and number one for me.

The researcher collected the data by following instruments as mentions chapter III. The researcher gave the figurative language lyrics of song to 5 students as sample to identify and analysis meaning.

Based on finding the data collection, the student's research as follow:

#### a. The students' Students' Understanding of of Simile

Simile is one of figurative language. While, simile is about compare two subjects. According to McMahan, Funk, Day said that simile is an imaginative comparison introduced by like or as or than. In the table above, almost all student interpret lyrics of Maher Zain with title "Hold My Hand". So, the lyrics *And we're still going on like nobody really cares* and almost all students' interpret the meaning is *Kita tetap melanjutkan semuanya seolah-olah tak ada yang peduli*. This lyric purely indicated into simile because that lyric used word *like*. And then the next lyric *Children seem like they're lost their smile*, and meaning is *Anak-anak itu seolah kehilangan senyuman mereka*. The lyrics was categorized simile, because child in generally need playing

playground with friend, so much time to feel happy and funny. In here the songwriter compare between *children* with *lost smile*. Then next lyrics songs with title “My little Girl”, you are *like shining stars into Kau bersinar layaknya bintang*. And then, *Now I will to try to love you like you love me* and the meaning is *Sekarang, saya akan mencoba untuk mencintaimu seperti kamu mencintaiku*. From the several sentences, in several sentences indicates word “like”, so that’s why those lyrics are Simile.

Metaphor is one of figurative language. While, Metaphor is about compare two subjects without connective words. According to McMahan, Funk, Day said that metaphor is an imaginative comparison in which two unlike things are compared by means of one element they have in common. In the table above, almost all student interpret the meaning of lyric with title "Hold my hand" *Life is shorter than most have thought* means hidup ini lebih singkat dari yang kita duga. And next lyric is *You're neighbor, my neighbor*, we're neighbor Kita bersaudara.

And then the next song title " My little girl" all students interpret the lyrics sentence *You are miracle* is Kamu begitu indah and lyric *You are a blessing from above* is kau adalah anugrah dari yang maha kuasa. And Also You are so innocent, so wonderful and pure kau begitu begitu murni, indah dan suci.

Almost all students interpret the meaning of lyric song title “Number one for me” *I was a foolish child* is *Aku hanyalah anak kecil yang konyol*. And the lyrics is *Mum, now I am here for you Ibu*, *aku ada disini untukmu* In metaphor the meaning *I was a foolish child* its means he didn’t understand anything because he is little child in the past, however now he stands up in front of his mother’s to evidence.

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McMahan, Funk, Day stated that personification, giving human characteristics to nonhuman things. Almost all student interpret the meaning in “Hold my hand” lyrics, *I hear the flower’s kind a crying loud* the word “*crying loud*” means shouting loud, so the meaning of lyrics is *ku dengar bunga-bunga menjerit keras*. This lyric categorized into personification, because this lyrics song assigning human characteristic to nonhuman object. As we know in the fact, that flower cannot to crying like human. The next lyric is *The breeze sound in sad* Jeritan yang menyedihkan. In the lyrics before the word “*breeze*” has human characteristic. So the lyrics contain metaphor.

Furthermore, almost all students interpreting the song title, “Palestine will be free” *I’m only a child but is your conscience still alive* means hanya sekedar anak kecil tapi apakah hati nuranimu masih hidup atau ada. And then, the next song title “Insyallah” *Haunt your mind and your heart is full of shame* means penuhi hati dan fikiran mu dengan penuh rasa malu. This lyric indicates to Metaphor, because give object of *mind* and *heart* human characteristic it was *shame*. The word *shame* one of human attitudes. And the last song with the title “Palestine will be free” *Cause your soul will always be free* means Jiwamu akan selalu bebas. In the lyric above is purely focus on Metaphor.

McMahan, Funk, Day stated that sometimes poems, like novels, stories, and plays, contain allusions (indirect references to famous persons, events, places, or to other works of literature). From the data above the researcher found the many varieties of lyrics is same. Almost all student interpreting the meaning of *this worldly life has end and it's then real life begins* means *kehidupan duniawi ini kan berakhir dan kehidupan yang sebenarnya akan mulai*. This lyric was contained Allusion, because the lyrics it refers to the places or events that everyone know means that lyrics is this life will end and when we death the real life it's begins. That lyrics remind us how we do running our life, it is bad way or good way that blessed by Allah. The next lyric is *Palestine will be free tomorrow* means *Palestina akan bebas*. As we know Palestine till know is face the wars, many people suffering, slaving and etc. the last lyric is *there is only one small planet were to be* means *Hanya satu planet tempat tinggal*. It is very general knowledge many people know the planet that can living is Earth. Those all the lyrics above is purely Allusion because its relates to event, event that everyone know and important events.

**e. The student result of Analyzing toward those figurative language**

Based on the result of analysis the simile, metaphor, personification, and allusion in lyrics Maher Zain's song that students' analyzed in 5 songs. Furthermore, from 7 (seventh) and the students' result analysis Simile, the researcher can concluded there is

no one who get interpreted “outstanding understanding”. There are 5 students’ who had “good understanding” with a percentage 80 %. And then, there are 2 students’ who had “good enough understanding” with a percentage 60%. In additions, from the data analysis Metaphor, there are 3 students’ who had a “good understanding” with a percentage value 70% - 80%. And there 3 are students’ who get “good enough understanding” with a percentage value 50%-60%. And the last there is 1 student who get “less understanding” with a percentage 40%.

From students’ result of analysis personification, there are 2 students’ who had a “good understanding” with a percentage 80%. And there 4 are students’ who get “good enough understanding” with a percentage 60%. And the last there is 1 student who get “less understanding” with a percentage 40%. The last is Allusion, there are 3 students’ who had a “good understanding” with a percentage 75%. And there are 4 students’ who get “good enough understanding” with a percentage 50%.

Based explanation above, the dominant of student understanding in analysis figurative language is Simile. Because there are 4 students’ can identify correctly with a percentage 80%. It is higher than 3 another types of figurative language. The percentage of metaphor is 70%-80%, however just 1 student can got percentage 80%. And then personification, there are 2 students who get score with a percentage 80%. And last is allusion, the higher percentage is 75%. So, based on explanation before, the higher of students understanding is Simile.

## B. Discussion

In this point the researcher presented the explanation about findings. While, the researcher focuses on simile, metaphor and personification in several of song lyrics in Maher Zain. Based on data above, the researcher needs to discuss the findings of the result the students' analyzing in several songs.

### 1. Simile

In this point the researcher would like to give some explanation about finding of student's result in analysis simile, one of type of figurative language. According to McMahan, Funk, Day said that simile is an imaginative comparison introduced by *like* or *as* or *than*. Based on the theory the researcher analyzed the students' result analysis Simile, the researcher can concluded there is no one who get interpreted "outstanding understanding". There are 5 students' who had "good understanding" with a percentage 80 %. The students who got "good understanding" is Student A, B, C, D and E. And then, there are 2 students' who had "good enough understanding" with a percentage 60%. In addition Hatch in Afriani stated that simile is a statement introduced by like or as. The structure of a simile is not too complicated. So, from the explanation of theory before, simile is easy to understand, to analysis and interpret the meaning that is contained in song lyrics. So, based on theory Simile have higher percentage rather than types of figurative language. From the 7 student's respondent, there are 5 students can answer well, with a percentage 80 %.

## **2. Metaphor**

McMahan, Funk, and Day stated that a metaphor is an imaginative comparison in which two unlike things are compared by means of one element they have in common. In addition, Lakoff in Afriani, states that metaphor is the expression of an understanding of one concept in terms of another concept, where there are some similarities or correlations between the two. So, metaphor is one of language style that compares a thing with another thing that has similarities.

Based on the theory the researcher analyzed the students' result analysis Metaphor, the researcher can concluded there is no one who get interpreted "outstanding understanding". And then, from the data analysis Metaphor, there are 3 students' who had a "good understanding" with a percentage value 70% - 80%. And there are 3 students' who get "good enough understanding" with a percentage value 50%-60%. And the last there is 1 student who get "less understanding" with a percentage 40%. The student who got "less understanding" is student B. so, student B more aware of the meaning that is contained in the song lyrics in identifying of the metaphor.

## **3. Personification**

McMahan, Funk, Day stated that those of us who love animals are so accustomed to personification, giving human characteristics to nonhuman things. In addition, Reaske in Afriani said that personification is the process of assigning human characteristics to nonhuman object, abstractions, or ideas".

From students' result of analysis personification, there are 2 students' who had a "good understanding" with a percentage 80%. And there 4 are students' who get "good

enough understanding” with a percentage 60%. And the last there is 1 student who get “less understanding” with a percentage 40%. The student who got “less understanding” is student G. so, student G more aware of the meaning that is contained in the song lyrics in identifying of the personification and increase the knowledge about figurative language.

#### **4. Allusion**

McMahan, Funk, Day stated that sometimes poems, like novels, stories, and plays, contain allusions (indirect references to famous persons, events, places, or to other works of literature). From students’ result of analysis personification, the researcher found there are 3 students’ who had a “good understanding” with a percentage 75%. And there are 4 students’ who get “good enough understanding” with a percentage 50%. So, all of student’s respondent more aware of the meaning that is contained in the song lyrics in identifying, interpreting and increase the knowledge about figurative language. Because from the others types of figurative language, Allusion is lower percentage. There no respondent got percentage upper 80 %.

#### **5. Student understanding of figurative language**

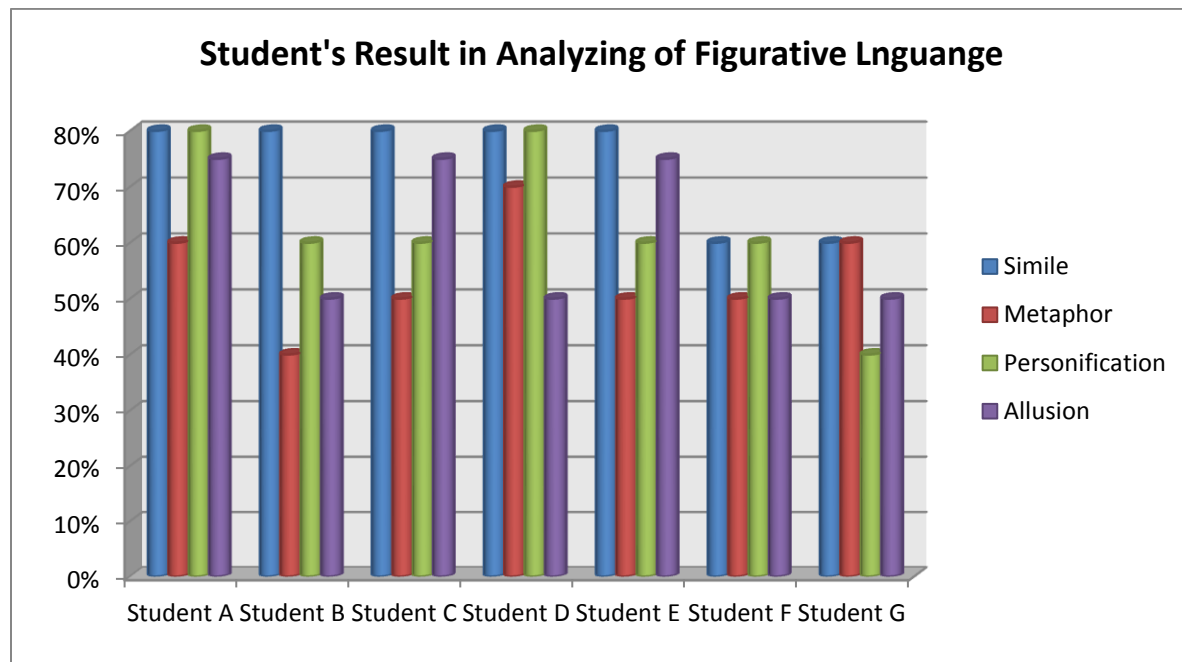
Based explanation above, the higher percentage of student understanding in analysis figurative language is Simile. Because there are 5 students’ can identify correctly with a percentage 80%. It is higher than 3 another types of figurative language. The percentage of metaphor is 70% - 80%, however just 1 student can got percentage 80% when analyzing metaphor. And then personification, there are 2 students who get score with a percentage 80%. And last is allusion, the higher percentage is 75%. So, based on explanation before, the higher of students understanding is Simile. The data proved that



the most all student have a “good understanding” category in analysis simile, metaphor, personification and allusion. In getting the clear picture, their results are presented in table and chart.

## **CHAPTER V**

### **CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION**

After presenting findings and discussion, the researcher draws some conclusions. First, the researcher concludes that students have a good understanding in identifying simile, metaphor, personification and allusion. It is obviously from 7 students result in identifying the types of figurative language are good understanding with a percentage 80 %. Second, from 7 students as sample, the higher percentage of understanding figurative language is Simile. Because from 7 students, there are 5 students who get "Good Understanding" rather than three types of figurative language. So the researcher can conclude that generally students' understanding in identifying and interpreting song lyrics that containing simile, metaphor, personification and Allusion.

#### **B. Suggestion**

After doing this research, the researcher would like to give some suggestions which may be useful for all persons. For the students before interpreting any figurative language, they also have the knowledge about simile, metaphor, personification and allusion both source language and target language. Furthermore, the researcher hopes this

research can be better and could as motivation to the other researchers who want to investigate in same field.
